Considering the rather local nature of our outings, this is quite good but there are many species which we might well encounter without going farther afield and we should certainly be alert for the sight of such. A few of these would be; Harlequin Duck, Rough-legged Hawk, Marbled Murrelet, Tufted Puffin, Long-eared Owl, Poorwill, Traill Flycatcher, Blue-gray Gnatcatcher, Hooded Oriole, and Red Crossbill. There are many others and, by extending our range, the list would increase mightily.
