Please remember to drop Dick a line or give him a call about the birds you've seen and would like to share with others.

Highlight of this summer's observations was the sub-adult, light phase Red-footed Booby at Pedro Point in the Pacifica area. First reported on 8/14, the bird was still in the vicinity on 8/18. This is the third reported occurrence of this species in California, the other two observations coming from the Farallon Islands.

- 8/9(?)- Sebastopol Sewer Ponds: Solitary Sandpiper (RMa)

6/6 - Anchor Bay: Tufted Puffin, Peregrine Falcons (DE, RM, DT)

Late June to mid-July - Fort Bragg: Common Nighthawks (DT)

- 6/26 MacKerricher SP: Wilson's Phalarope (DT)
- 7/7 Mt Lassen NP: Clark's Nutcrackers, Cassin's Finch, Mountain Bluebird, Williamson's Sapsucker (RR)
- 7/23 8/18 MacKerricher SP: Lesser Golden Plover (DT)
- 7/25 Elk: Grasshopper Sparrow carrying food (DT)
- 8/2 MacKerricher SP: Baird's Sandpiper (DT)



June 8-15 - Elegant Trogon (nest with young), Painted Redstart (nest with young), Black-throated Sparrow, Verdin, Northern Beardless Tyrannulet, Whiskered Screech Owl, Sulphur-bellied Flycatcher, Bridled Titmouse, Olive Warbler, Greater Pewee; Broad-billed, Blue-throated, Black-chinned, Broad-tailed, and Magnificent Hummingbirds; Vermilion Flycatcher, Black-tailed Gnatcatcher and MORE!!

BODEGA BAY REPORT

Ruth Rudesill organized a summertime field trip to Bodega Bay on August 16. Twenty people showed up and observed 69 species. They included a lot of Pigeon Guillemots, Elegant Terns, an Osprey fishing, White and Brown Pelicans, and 2 possible Pectoral Sandpipers. There were quite a few sandpipers but very few grebes and loons and ducks around. The weather was calm with high fog overcast and very pleasant at lunchtime.
