Highlights of the trip included: a Chestnut-sided Warbler at Hole-in-the-Head; four American Redstarts; 2 early Dunlin at Doran Park; an adult Parasitic Jaeger and a Cassin's Auklet off Bodega Head; and numerous Elegant Terns.
