Program: Don Nelson will demonstrate 21st century bird photography techniques. You will not want to miss this important meeting. Dan Nelson saw 284 (73%) of the species in Sonoma Co. during 1992, and he has slides and videos of many of them, including rarities.

MISCELLANEOUS

Birds of Sonoma County, by Parmeter and

Bolander, 4th printing, has been completed and will be ready for distribution at the January meeting, according to Bertha Rains. The addendum has been updated to include the most recent sightings: Tricolored Heron and Lucy's Warbler (last minute addition). A list of nesting birds in the county including all recent data has been included. As the book went to press, the total number of birds for Sonoma County was 387. Please reserve your copy of this important book immediately. (It is required reading for all RROS members).

Appreciation to Warren Thom Knudsen is given for legal assistance and advice in obtaining incorporation and status as a public foundation. His careful attention to details was necessary to guide us through the process of dealing with governmental agencies. We sincerely appreciate the time, effort and courtesy he has given to RROS.

When we applied and received status as a public foundation in 1988, the status was conditional for four years. Incorporation permits tax exemption for RROS and authorizes members to deduct contributions on their income taxes. This fall we filed for status as a public foundation, and in November final approval was granted.

OBSERVATIONS

Several older records reported to the observational editor, Avis Anderson, were deleted since they are of minimal value to most of our group at this time. Because there was a paucity of local records reported, the editor included those from other Northern California counties. Observations made on the CBCs and later will be included next month.
