

Trillium Delights, maker of gourmet food products, together with the Mendocino Coast Chapter of the National Audubon Society are sponsoring a day of birding along the "Skunk" railroad tracks, on Sunday, March 1, 1998.

The train will travel from Fort Bragg to the Northspur Station located about half way to Willits. The route borders the Noyo River and offers good birding habitat. Small groups of birders, each with an expert leader, will disembark the train every few miles, bird for about three hours, and then be picked up at whatever point they have reached and transported to Northspur. Lunch will be served at Northspur, and there will be a tally with prizes for the team with the most birds and the team with the most unusual bird. After lunch there will be several options available for the afternoon's activities.

Departure will be at 8:00 a.m. from the fort Bragg Depot, with return at about 4:00 p.m. The cost is \$35, *including lunch*. Please call Dorothy Tobkin (Toby) with any questions: 707-964-6216. We need to be sure by mid-February of 35 places sold in order to charter the train for this unusual birding adventure, so please respond promptly if you are interested. Redwood Region Ornithological Society was organized in 1962 "to encourage the study and conservation of birds, other wildlife, and their natural habitat." Meetings are held the second Thursday of each month, September through May. Regular general meetings (October through April) are held at 7:30 pm in Room 221 Darwin Hall, Sonoma State University, Rohnert Park, California.
