FIELD TRIP RESULTS - Potluck Birding - January 15
7 birders went all over the area and a total of 71 species were seen. Some of the high-lights were 2 Rough-legged Hawks, an Osprey and a Prairie Falcon all on Estero Road. A Barn Owl and a Burrowing Owl. A probable Nashville Warbler and the Harris' Sparrow.

OBSERVATIONS -- Dan Nelson (762-6152)

After causing a loud explosion, an out of place Double-crested Cormorant was found along Sonoma Ave. still smoking from the 12,000 volts that electrocuted it when it collided with high power cables (DN). Elsewhere, a fem. Barrow's Goldeneye was in a flock of Goldeneyes along Old Lakeville Rd. #3 on 1/30 (DN). A Cooper's Hawk was seen near downtown Santa Rosa on 1/6, and carried a Red-breasted Sapsucker in it's talons (RL). A Rough-legged Hawk was in western Petaluma on 1/25, and another was near Sears Point raceway on 1/30 (both DN). A Prairie Falcon was noted near Crane Canyon Rd. on 2/2 (DN). An Osprey and a Green Heron were both found at Spring Lake on 1/5 (HC, B&BR). The Rock Sandpiper was still at Bodega Head on 1/19 (HC,FB). A Lesser Yellowlegs was noted at Shields Marsh, Marin Co. on 1/11 (HC,RH,SC). An early Violet-green Swallow visited the Petaluma sewer ponds on 1/30 (DN). A good find was the fem. Northern Oriole found in Wikiup on 1/24 (B&BR).Both White-throated Sparrows continue their presence at S.R.J.C., (DN), and another has been visiting a feeder daily in Petaluma since 1/21 (W&CN, LW, DN). The Harris' Sparrow continues to be seen along Walker Road throughout the month (MOB).
