FIELD TRIP RESULTS - Willow Creek Rd., Oct. 14

Approximately 14 RROS birders joined leader Doug Ellis in owling and birding on a day that started out nice and ended up windy. A total of 62 species were seen: Western Grebe, Pied-billed Grebe, Double-crested Cormorant, Mallard, Surf Scoter, Ruddy Duck, Common Merganser, Turkey Vulture, Red-tailed Hawk, Red-shouldered Hawk, Golden Eagle, American Kestrel, California Quail, Virginia Rail, American Coot, Glaucous-winged Gull, Ring-billed Gull, Band-tailed Pigeon, Screech Owl, Great-horned Owl, Pygmy Owl, Spotted Owl, Anna's Hummingbird, Common Flicker, Pileated Woodpecker, Hairy Woodpecker, Downy Woodpecker, Black Phoebe, Stellar's Jay, Scrub Jay, Common Raven, Chestnut-backed Chickadee, Bushtit,

Red-breasted Nuthatch, Wrentit, Winter Wren, Bewick's Wren, Long-billed Marsh Wren, Mockingbird, American Robin, Varied Thrush, Hermit Thrush, Golden-crowned Kinglet, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Water Pipit, Cedar Waxwing, Starling, Hutton's Vireo, Yellow-rumped Warbler, Black-throated Gray Warbler, Brewer's Blackbird, Purple Finch, Pine Siskin, American Goldfinch, Lesser Goldfinch, Red Crossbill, Rufous-sided Towhee, Brown Towhee, Rufous-crowned Sparrow, Dark-eyed Junco, White-crowned Sparrow, Golden-crowned Sparrow, Fox Sparrow, Song Sparrow.

9/28, In Pt.Reyes area were several Lawrence's Goldfinches, 2 Blue-gray Gnatcatchers and a Chestnut-sided Warbler near the lighthouse, a Black-throated Blue Warbler and a Tennessee Warbler at Nunes Ranch, and a Solitary Sandpiper at Spaletta Ranch and a Blackpoll Warbler at the Fish Docks (BDP). 9/29, at Hayward Regional Park, a Dusky Warbler, Lark Bunting and Peregrine Falcon. At Pt. Reyes on Spaletta Ranch a Golden Eagle, Ferruginous Hawk, Prairie and Peregrine Falcon, 3 Lesser Golden Plovers and a Solitary Sandpiper, an American Redstart on the Nunes Ranch. Off the coast were 500 Black-vented Shearwaters (BDP). 10/2, Annadel Park, Hermit Thrush (CW, HC). 10/3, Bodega Bay, Spud Point, 2 Lesser Golden Plovers and 3 Elegant Terns (FB, HC). 10/5, a Magnolia Warbler at Road Forks Pond, Bay-breasted Warbler at Nunes Ranch, White-winged Dove and Canada Warbler at the New Willows (DN). A Blackpoll Warbler at Mendoza Ranch and Canada Warbler at the New Willows on 10/6 (DN, W&CN). Also on 10/6 at the Marin Head Ponds 2 Prairie Falcons, Redhead and 2 Canvasbacks (DE). 10/6, Santa Maria, CA a very rare Little Curlew and near Hearst Castle an unusual White Wagtail (BDP). Reyes, Black and White Warbler at Nune's ranch and 4 Lapland Longspurs at Spaletta Ranch (BDP). 10/10, on Skaggs Island were 2 Burrowing Owls, Barn Owl and American Bittern (FB). 10/11, Pt. Reyes Fish Docks, Gray Flycatcher (KC, DE.) 10/14, Willow Creek Rd., 3Spotted Owls, Red Crossbills, many Varied Thrush, Red-breasted Nuthatches, Golden Eagle, Rufous-crowned Sparrow. Russian River, 3 Common Mergansers (DE, B&BR & RROS Group). 10/15, Cader Lane, Horned Lark, Wilson's Phalaropes, 3 Lesser Yellowlegs, 2 Say's Phoebes (JS, JT). 10/15 & 10/16, an early imm. White-throated Sparrow at a feeder in Petaluma (WN). 10/20, Bodega Bay, Cooper's Hawk, Virginia Rail (FB, HC). 10/20, Warm Springs Dam and Rockpile Rd., Red-breasted Sapsucker, Black-shouldered Kite, 21 Pine Siskins, 8 Blue Grouse, 2 Pileated Woodpeckers, 35 Varied Thrush (JS, JT). 10/25, Willowside Rd. near bridge, Canada Warbler, Swamp Sparrow, Lincoln's Sparrow, Sora, Virginia Rail (DE).
