WANT TO AVOID WINDOW KILLS?

My wife, Trish, came up with an approach to <u>keeping birds away from windows</u>. It has definitely been an improvement over other methods we have tried. There have been no birds down recently.

She purchased GelGems locally but cannot remember where. The website: www.gelgems.com will tell you how and where to buy.

Gelgems come in several shapes and colors. The ones we have found most effective are shaped like little stars of several colors. A little water (or better yet, spit) adheres these transparent colorful stars to the window. It seems to take only a few GelGems for each pane that seems to attract birds. They have been effective for us.

We have no financial interest in GelGems.
