SEPT. 10, Monday - Join leader Peter Leveque at 6:30 p.m, to witness a whirling vortex of thousands of migrating Vaux's Swifts as these tiny birds descend into their temporary nighttime roost in a large chimney on the campus of Rio Lindo Academy in Healdsburg.

Directions: Heading north on Hwy 101, take the Old Redwood Highway/Healdsburg Avenue Exit. Go north to Bailhache Ave., turn right and continue for about 3 miles to the entrance of Rio Lindo Academy. Turn left at first stop sign, then left again just before the dormitory. Go ½ block to the rear of the campus. The chimney is on a side street west of the athletic field. Experienced swift watchers bring lawn chairs and hats.

spectacular. Highlights included excellent views of Rufous-crowned Sparrows, Purple Martins, and Olive-sided Flycatchers as well as many views of the always-beautiful Lazuli Bunting. We heard Bell's Sparrows at the top of the road. (Continued on Page three)
