NOV. 10 - Sat. Field Trip to Shollenberger Park (Petaluma) Meet at 8:00AM at the public parking lot on Cader Lane, off So. McDowell Blvd. After lunch we will continue for a ride-through and brief stop at Tolay Park, thence to Port Sonoma. We will search for land and marsh birds, waterfowl, gulls and shorebirds. FIELD TRIP REPORT - BODEGA BAY, OCT.20 Mike Parmeter, leader

We started birding early at Bodega Head where the weather was warm without a bit of breeze. Highlights included dozens of Buller's Shearwaters off shore. Also 5 – 7 Ancient Murrelets were closer in, and a Peregrine Falcon flew by. At the Hole-In-The-Head a clear view of a Sora was had by all. Several White-winged Scoters were found along the westside shore (4 or 5 birds). A single female Ring-necked Duck at the north end of the harbor was unusual. At high tide a large horde of shorebirds gathered in the area just west of the Sandpiper Restaurant. This included 4 Red Knots, 15 Ruddy Turnstones, and 15 Surfbirds, all in alternate plumage. Marbled Godwits here were estimated at 700 birds. Twenty-one birders were in attendance.
