Field Trip Reports from Ruth Rudesill

September 28th - Five participants enjoyed the warm weather at outer Point Reyes NS. 66 species were observed. The group observed some Wood Ducks at Whitehouse Pool. It was warmest I ever remember at the Lighthouse: highlights were a handsome male American Redstart, several Redbreasted Nuthatches, Yellow Warblers, Yellow-rumped Warblers, an Orange-crowned Warbler, a Blue-gray Gnatcatcher, Say's and Black Phoebe as well as great scope looks at a Peregrine Falcon and Rock Wren. Not much at Fish Docks other than a dark Merlin, and good looks at the Greathorned Owls. There were two Common Moorhen at the pond at Drakes Beach. More western migrants at the RCA trees, and about 2 dozen White-tailed Kites sitting on the fences in the field behind there (towards Abbotts Lagoon.) Several Gray Whales were observed. The Black-tailed Deer rut is in full swing with several stags encountered following females. There are quite a few immature Elephant Seals on Drakes Beach.

October 12th -Six participants enjoyed warm weather at Bodega Harbor. 81 species were observed without looking at the shorebirds! Highlights- a Palm Warbler (of the western race) at Hole in the Head pond at Campbell Cove. David Hofmann spotted a handsome male Black Scoter


