FIELD TRIPS - January, 2011

Las Gallinas Sewage Ponds, January 8, 2010 - This popular Marin birding spot is just south of Petaluma. We are likely to see a variety of raptors, dabbling and diving ducks, shorebirds and land birds in field and trees. Plan to walk. Bring optics, layers of clothes, water, snack and lunch, field guides, hats and sunscreen. FIELD TRIP REPORTS

Point Reyes Outer Peninsula, September 25, 2010, Leader Peter Colasanti - This prescheduled vagrant trip was fueled by hope, but dependant on luck, which eluded us, and meteorological conditions, which were lovely but not conducive to avian vagrancy. However, wandering from Whitehouse Pool to the lighthouse, investigating Fish Docks, Nunes, Mendoza and the RCA Receiving Station - 68 species were observed. Better birds included a Merlin at Drake's Beach, 3 Peregrine Falcons at the lighthouse, 3 Great Horned and one Barn Owl, pairs of Pacificslope Flycatchers and Red-breasted Nuthatches. There was a Warbling Vireo at Chimney Rock plus Yellow and Yellow-rumped Warblers, and a few swarms of Tricolored Blackbirds at Mendoza. Vic Fazio Wildlife Area - Nov. 13, 2010 - This field trip was accompanied by very nice weather, good birds and 87 species overall. There were no outstanding rarities, but we did have an American Bittern at Vic Fazio and two Burrowing Owls along Flannery Rd. in Solano County. Along Woodbridge Road, there were roughly 2,000 Sandhill Cranes and close to 700 Cackling Geese of the Aleutian variety. Tuesday Outing to Capay Valley and Colusa NWR - Nov 16, 2010 Reported by Ruth Rudesill Glorious fall weather dominated this outing to the far reaches of Yolo County and later for sunset in Colusa County. North of Winters in the farmland looking for the Cassin's Kingbird, and were finally rewarded with scope views. Other good birds here included Red-breasted Sapsucker, Say's Phoebe, and Loggerhead Shrike. We traveled up Capay Valley stopping along Cache Creek and drove up a canyon into the mountains where we lunched. We ended the day viewing thousands of waterfowl at the Colusa NWR. Highlights: a cooperative Rock Wren, Prairie Falcon, Peregrine Falcon, several Golden Eagles, Virginia Rail, Eurasian Wigeon, "blue" Snow Goose and a bathing Red-shouldered Hawk!
