RROS General Meeting Thursday, January 13, 2011 7- 9 PM

"Raptors of Sonoma County" Speaker: Larry Broderick

Larry Broderick, Birding Consultant for the Sonoma Land Trust, where they call him the "Raptor Magnet," will offer his skills with recognizing and understanding some of Nature's most magnificent predators. Larry is a nature enthusiast who loves all things wild. He has introduced hundreds of eager bird watchers to birds of prey, teaching them how to distinguish the various species and morphs by size, behavior, habitat, color and markings. But he goes beyond the basic science to help his audience understand the risks these beautiful creatures face as well, from giant wind turbines to poisons we use for common pest control. We are very pleased that Larry has offered to share his love of birds with us.

<u>Directions to the meeting:</u> From Hwy 101 take Hwy 116 West toward Sebastopol. Turn right (north) on Llano Rd. and go ~ 1 mile to **Laguna Wastewater Treatment Plant at 4300 Llano Rd, Santa Rosa**. Look for an open gate on right. Proceed to Administration Bldg. at SE corner of the plant. From Hwy. 12, take Llano Rd. south about 3 miles. Plant is on left.

2011 FIELD TRIPS

Las Gallinas Sewage Ponds - January 8, 2011

Lake County - February 12, 2011

Local Guide, Darlene Hecomovich, Lake County CBC compiler and lifelong Lake County birder, will take us to her favorite Lake County birding spots. We will begin the birding day at Rodman Slough (possible Least Bittern). Other spots might include Reclamation Road, Lakeside Community Park, Clear Lake State Park, Anderson Marsh and Borax Lake. There will be stops in between as time allows. Bring optics, layers of clothes, sunscreen, food for a long day, field guides, plenty of water and a fun attitude. Meet at the PG&E substation on River Road for carpooling at 7:15 A.M. We will travel up Hwy 101 to Ukiah to Hwy 20 east. Time to Rodman Slough is about 1 Hr, 30 Min. Birding Leader is Lisa Hug. Special June Fieldtrip in Kernville area

Thursday, June 23 - Monday, June 27, 2011 - This will be an incredible trip lead by Bob Barnes, a highly respected professional birding leader in the Kernville area. He will lead us into varied habitats for 3 ½ days (see below). Rooms are reserved at the Sequoia Lodge, located 3 miles north of Kernville on the river. You must call Pat at 760-376-2535 to reserve one of the RROS rooms in your name with a credit card. Do not do this on line. Unreserved rooms will be held until June 15th then released. There is camping in the area, as well. The trip is limited to 15 people. Expect to carpool, no exceptions. Parking spots are minimal at many of his stops. Bob charges \$250/ day which covers all of his expenses. That amount will be divided among the participants. Bob's fees are due by June 10th.

Bob's comments: Due to the style of birding (participant limit) and places to pull-off the road (vehicle limit), I recommend setting a limit of 15 participants and 4-5 cars for the Kern trip. 250.00 per day (\$25 per day per person based on ten people; \$16.67 per day per person based on fifteen people) all inclusive covering: 1. my driving for two other people who wish to ride with me; 2. my gasoline; 3. my leadership; 4. my lodging; 5. my meals & snacks; 6. a tax deductible donation to the Arthur & Sidney R. Barnes Family Foundation (after my out-of-pocketed expenses are subtracted); 7. my tip (the donation included in the cost), and 8. my thorough scouting during the weeks and days leading up to the trip, plus field checklists, itineraries, maps, and target birds list. Four days on site will give us one full day off the weekend (Friday) in Mojave Desert/Great Basin habitat; two weekend mornings on the Kern River Preserve, two weekend afternoons in the mountains (Great Basin and/or traditional west side Sierra Nevada), and one morning in the Giant Sequoia National Monument. 
