Field Trip Reports for April

Mines Rd and Del Valle Reg Park in Livermore - April 12, 2011

We had a great day in southern Alameda County! Seven eager participants enjoyed the day despite a cool breeze most of the day. We observed 75 species and a Bobcat crossed the road in front of us! Participants: Betty Groce, Terry & Gary Haag, Karen Nagel, Rob O'Donnell, Glenda Ross, and Ruth Rudesill

Everyone spotted birds for the group! Highlights included: Great Horned Owl on a nest with an owlet, adult Bald Eagle, adult and imm Golden Eagles, Osprey, Red -tailed Hawk nest, a Bank Swallow, great looks at Yellow-billed Magpies, Bullock's Orioles, Common Yellowthroat, Orange-cr Warbler, Rufous-crowned Sparrow, and the courtship flight of three male Phainopeplas with scope looks of a female in the treetop.

This will be the last Tuesday outing for the year. Thank you to all who participated!

Bodega Bay and Harbor - Sunday, April 17, 2011

This RROS field trip covered Bodega Bay/Harbor and logged just under 90 species. We had great looks at waterfowl (Eared and Horned Grebes, Common and Red-throated Loons) and waders (godwits, Willets, Surfbirds, Short-billed Dowitchers, both species of turnstones) all going into varying degrees of alternate plumage. The first year male Harlequin Duck was still present hanging out near Spud Point. The Eurasian Widgeon was still present in the pond near the entrance to Doran Beach. Two Peregrine Falcons did a fly-by later in the afternoon. There was some degree of migration happening with Caspian Terns, as we saw approximately 50 birds flying north between 8am and 10am. 
