

December - No Saturday December Field Trip planned – Please help with the Dec. 18<sup>th</sup> Santa Rosa Christmas Count. Other local counts also need your help.

## January 12 - 14 - Panoche Valley and Los Banos area

Martin Luther King weekend, we will have a weekend trip to Panoche Valley and Merced Wildlife areas. The trip leaves just south of Hollister at the Paicines Reservior at 8 a.m. on Saturday. We will spend the day birding the Panoche Valley which is exceptional in winter for raptors. Many years there are Mountain Plovers, Chukars, rare sparrows and Long-eared Owls. Note that the Panoche Valley is famous for very few restrooms.

We will spend Saturday night in Los Banos. Rooms are reserved at the Americas Best Value Inn. There are 5 double rooms and 4 king bed rooms reserved under RROS for January 15. The cost is about \$59 for a double and \$52 for a king. All rooms are non-smoking. Smoking rooms are available. Call 209-826-5002 for reservations. They will hold these rooms until January 1st.

Sunday at 8 a.m. we will bird the Wild Life Refuges around Los Banos, for wintering water birds and whatever is around, finishing the day on the Sante Fe Grade heading northwest towards Highway 5 and home.

The drive time to Hollister is about 3 hrs. & 15 minutes from Santa Rosa. The drive time from Gustine to Santa Rosa is about 3 hrs. We will finish the day on Sunday around 3 p.m. There is a Best Western in Hollister if you wish to spend Friday night there before meeting at Paicines.

The trip will be loosely led by Ellen Blustein and Lisa Hug. Because the trip is a loop, all carpooling must originate in Sonoma County. Participants will receive directions and meal plans if they need them.

Saturday, February 11, 2012 - Wintering Birds of Solano and Yolo Counties, 8am - 4pm

The open agricultural lands of southern Solano County provide excellent foraging habitat for scores of wintering raptors, while the wetlands of the nearby Yolo Basin Wildlife Area are the winter home for thousands of waterfowl including ducks, geese, swans and many shorebirds. This all-day field trip will visit several local habitats in search of wintering Ferruginous and Rough-legged hawks; Merlin; Prairie Falcon; Burrowing, Barn and Great-horned Owls; Longbilled Curlew as well as the elusive and threatened Mt. Plover. We also expect to see a representative sampling of waterfowl and a variety of shorebirds at the Yolo Basin Wildlife Area, aka the Vic Fazio refuge. Participants meet the leader at 8:00am in Dixon in the southwest corner of the Wal-Mart parking lot located on East Dorset Drive at the Hwy 113 exit off I-80. ## Field Trip Report for November 12th, Central Valley

The November 12<sup>th</sup> Central Valley Field Trip to sites including Staten Island (San Joaquin County), Consumnes River Preserve and Desmond Road (Sacramento County) and Flannery and Robinson Roads (Solano County) was co-led by Becky Olsen and Ken Wilson and attended by 15 other birders and members of RROS. Starting in Staten Island we were immediately impressed by the many thousands of Cackling Geese mostly, if not all, of the sub-species Aleutian, *Branta hutchinsii leucopareia*. Snow, Ross's and Greater White-fronted Geese were not present in great numbers, though occasional small flocks flew amongst the armada of Cackling Geese that filled the skies throughout the morning. Before leaving the "Island" we enjoyed great looks at many other species including large numbers of Tundra Swans and two different races of Sandhill Cranes.

Following lunch at the Consumnes Preserve and a short walk along the forested trails, we drove the Desmond Road loop and saw an adult Bald Eagle fly over and watched Northern Harriers hunting the fields. Returning to the Preserve, we walked the boardwalks among Cinnamon teals, Northern Shoveler's, an elusive Virginia Rail and Wilson's Snipe. Alerted to the presence of an American Bittern by other birders, we were treated to a visually satisfying fly-by (see photo on page one), a fitting end to our short visit here before we drove to Solano County in search of the elusive Mountain Plovers.

While looking for Mountain Plovers we found a Burrowing Owl observing us from the rock pile by the bridge on Flannery Road and a short time later had very good looks at a hunting Ferruginous Hawk. Later on Robinson Road, while still looking for plovers we had distant scope views of a Merlin and a Prairie Falcon. Finally we found our flock of plovers accompanied by Long-billed Curlews. Though distant this was still satisfying, high fives all round until one sharp-eyed observer noted that when the flock took to the air they sported black axillaries - Black-bellied Plovers!

Our total species count for the day was 89.


